- The Peterborough Woman's Club Scholarship was established to honor and recognize a high school senior girl from the ConVal School District for outstanding service to her school and community.
- One \$1500 scholarship will be awarded directly to the recipient in June of the year she enters college.
- Applicants must be high school senior girls residing in the ConVal School District.
- **Of greatest importance in selecting a recipient is the applicant's record of service to individuals and organizations in her school and our community.**
- **The application deadline is Wed. April 8, 2026 at 3:00pm.** ConVal students should complete their application through their Naviance accounts. Students from outside ConVal High may submit this application with all supporting materials by that same date and time via email to laurenmartin24@gmail.com.
- **Application requirements:**
 - Peterborough Woman's Club scholarship application or (for ConVal students only) the ConVal Common Scholarship Application
 - Official high school transcript
 - Three letters of recommendation: one letter must be from an adult who provided oversight or guidance to the applicant during community service activities.
 - After the above materials are received, each applicant will receive notice by email of her interview appointment with the scholarship committee.
- The scholarship committee's decision will be announced at the ConVal senior awards night. The recipient and her adult guest will be honored at the Peterborough Woman's Club annual meeting in mid-June.
